Program Compliance

Annually, on or before October 1, the Superintendent or designee will determine Educational Service District 112 is in compliance with the following program requirements:

- A. Appropriate measures are taken to safeguard all student and ESD 112 permanent records against loss or damage;
- B. Provision is made for the supervision of instructional practices and procedures;
- C. Current basic instructional materials are available for required courses of study;
- D. A program of guidance, counseling, and testing services is maintained, as appropriate, for students in all grades offered by the ESD;
- E. The physical facilities of each building are adequate and appropriate for the educational program offered;
- F. There is adequate provision for the health and safety of all students within the custody of ESD 112;
- G. ESD 112 follows the statutes which prohibit unequal treatment of individuals on the basis of race, sex, creed, color, honorably discharged veteran, sexual orientation, presence of any sensory, mental or physical disability; and
- H. Within each program, the program director has determined that appropriate student discipline is established and enforced. The program director has conferred with the ESD 112 administration, where appropriate, and employees in the building in order to develop and/or review building disciplinary standards and the uniform enforcement of those standards.
