

Parent and Student Rights in Administration of Surveys, Analysis or Evaluations

All instructional materials, including supplementary materials and teacher manuals, used with any survey, analysis, or evaluation in a program or project supported by federal funds are available for inspection by parents and guardians.

No student participating in ESD 112 programs will be required as part of any project or program supported by federal funds to submit to survey, analysis, or evaluation that reveals information concerning the following without the prior consent of adult or emancipated students, or written permission of parents:

- A. Political affiliations;
- B. Potentially embarrassing mental or psychological problems;
- C. Sexual behavior and attitudes;
- D. Illegal, anti-social, self-incriminating or demeaning behavior;
- E. Critical appraisals of close family members;
- F. Privileged or similar relationships;
- G. Religious practices, affiliations, or beliefs of the student or student's parent; or
- H. Income other than information necessary to establish eligibility for a program.

ESD 112 will make arrangements to protect student privacy during the administration of surveys and the collection, disclosure or use of personal information for marketing, sales or other distribution purposes.
