WEEK 4: We spent two days doing fun and creative engineering experiments with Vickei Hrdina, the STEM Director at ESD 112. Our experiments involved magnets and levitation and we designed a complete mag-lev transportation system! After that, we had a visit from the master storyteller, Chris Leebrick from FVRL. On our last day, we took a field trip to the Waterfront Park in Hood River, OR with Cascadia Education Adventure School and did lots of fun activities including kayaking, paddle boarding, and watched a kiteboarding demonstration. The trip was a great way to end the week, and an awesome way to finish our summer program!
